



Tours And Workshops Schedule

Space is limited. Approximately 30 minutes per session. **Please note** some programs involve walking, including portions on sand. Gather near Tour Flag 15 minutes before start time.

Seining! Join park educators and use a seine net to catch and observe marine life in Barnegat Bay.
